

NATURE TRACKS EXCURSION

On Saturday, May 19th the South Carolina Railroad Museum's Rockton Rion and Western Railroad will be operating the fifth annual *NatureTracks* excursion train. Noted SCETV series *NatureScene* host and naturalist Rudy Mancke will again narrate this unique experience. *NatureTracks* is an opportunity to ride on an open air car through scenic Fairfield County while Rudy points out and discusses the natural resources and wildlife native to the area. During the five mile trip to Rion, Rudy will occasionally stop the train and highlight points of interest that are unique and distinctive to the countryside. Upon arrival in Rion, a light lunch will be served while passengers can ask Rudy questions about the sights seen during the excursion. Comfortable attire is suggested.
